

# Advanced Seminars (10 MCs)

(level 4000)

Students are required to take at least two 4000 level courses or courses listed as advanced seminars in their third and fourth years.

#### Capstone (10 MCs)

(level 4000)

Two capstone seminars are to be taken during fourth year. In the first semester, students will carry out a **research project**. In the second semester, students will complete it and **write a capstone report**.
